



Rodney "Hot Rod" Miller

Rodney Miller was born September 9, 1937 in Church Point, Louisiana. In 1950 at age 13 he played with Russell Bearb Band and several local bands. In 1952 at age 15 he played fiddle with "The Walter Mouton Band". In 1954 at age 17, a junior in high school, he joined Lawrence Walker's band, playing steel guitar seven nights a week. Then he went to play with "The Aldus Roger Band", playing seven nights a week for 14 years.

When Cajun music sort of faded out, Rodney formed his own band, playing Rock & Roll music for 10 years, then when Cajun music came back to life he worked with Belton Richard's Band for 15 years. Over the years Rodney recorded with over 75 bands.

In 1984 Rodney played at The World's Fair in New Orleans, Louisiana with Jerry Fountain band.

After retirement due to ill health, March 21, 2008, Rodney joined Jay Cormier's band playing five nights a week.
